



The Network for Oral and Bone Health Research (RSBO) and the MENTOR program are pleased to announce a new funding opportunity :

## RSBO – MENTOR POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP

### One fellowship of \$38,000

Deadline: March 31st 2011

Results announced on April 30<sup>th</sup> 2011

#### Eligibility criteria:

- Be a postdoctoral student registered at a Quebec university (start date of July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 at the latest);
- Be co-supervised by a MENTOR and a regular member of the Network for Oral and Bone Health Research;
- Submit a project in line with the research priorities of MENTOR and the RSBO. Arthritis-related research is excluded from this competition. The submitted project should be in compliance with the ethical rules in force at the institution associated with the research. Evidence of multidisciplinary training, considered an advantage in the development of future musculo-skeletal researchers, must be included in the submitted project.
- The applications to the RSBO-MENTOR postdoctoral fellowship will be evaluated by a peer-review committee constituted of members of the RSBO and MENTOR programs.
- The evaluation criteria of the applications to the RSBO-MENTOR postdoctoral fellowship are:
  - Evaluation of the candidate (education, training, publications, previous awards, career plan, reference letters);
  - Evaluation of the co-supervisors (publications, grants, awards, prizes, supervisory experience, pertinence of expertise with the proposed project, each co-supervisor meeting the program requirements);
  - Evaluation of the project (clarity, objectives, methodology, feasibility, potential impact on musculo-skeletal research);
  - Evidence of multidisciplinaryity.
- Funding is currently for one (1) year.

## Required documents:

- A description of the proposed project (*maximum 2 pages - font Times New Roman 12 points, margin 2 cm*) indicating:
  - Project title;
  - Objectives;
  - Methodology and timeline;
  - Data analysis plan;
  - Feasibility and pertinence of the project;
  - Bioethical aspects.
- A description of the expected training and anticipated career path (*maximum 1 page - police Times New Roman 12 points, margin 2 cm*);
- The candidate's curriculum vitae (listing any current fellowship, amount and duration);
- A letter of recommendation from each designated co-supervisor (MENTOR and RSBO);
- A copy of each co-supervisor's biosketch.
